


Innovative Modular Track

The concept of the modular track allows the rail to be assembled on site giving faster delivery, often within 24 hours and sometimes even the same day.

at both ends of the track and for your convenience 2 remotes are supplied as standard.


Staircase Configurations

Each track is built directly on site and pieces together to hug the contours of your staircase. A curved stairlift installation takes approx. 3-4 hours.

To make your life even easier we can install tracks with top and bottom wraps / run ons, taking you precisely to where you need to be.






Our curved stairlifts are available to buy new or reconditioned, we even supply this stairlift as a rental.

Hinged Track





Where space is limited, or the stairlift rail would present an obstruction, our hinged rail is the ideal solution.

The lightweight rail automatically folds out of the way leaving your hallway clear while your stairlift is not in use.

The stairlift can be parked in one of its charge points using the remote control provided.





Features of the Bison 180 Curved Stairlift

As expected with a quality product the Bison 180 has many features fitted as standard to aid your comfort and use.



Padded seat and backrest.

Folding arms, footrest and seat allow easy access to the stairway.

Lockable on/off switch allows the user to prevent others from using the lift.

Five safety sensors stop the lift automatically if any obstruction

Easy to use swivel seat fitted as standard

The paddle lever allows you to effortlessly swivel the seat for safe exit and entry onto the stairlift, however for your convenience you may wish to opt for a powered swivel(Please ask for more details).

Easy release seat belt

For your safety and comfort all our curved stairlifts are fitted with inertia seat belts.

Finger light control

Fitted with an easy-to-use Rocker Switch on both arms, the stairlift can be operated with ease, even for those with limited dexterity.







Safety Features as standard

Your safety is of the utmost importance to Leodis Stairlifts. The curved stairlifts that we supply and install have standard safety features, as expected of the leading manufacturers.



Safety Sensors

Should your stairlift encounter an obstruction on the staircase the safety sensors on the footplate will immediately halt your stairlift. To release, operate the stairlift in the opposite direction and remove the object before continuing on your journey.

Diagnostic Display

The Bison 180 stairlift is fitted with a lockable isolation key to prevent unauthorised use of your stairlift and an on/off switch.

A clear diagnostic display allows you to monitor the status of your stairlift and aids any fault-finding. This can often lead to problems being resolved with a quick telephone call rather than the need for a call out.



Curved Rental Option

If you only need a stairlift for a short time, following an injury, operation or if you have a relative coming to stay, our rental stairlifts offer the perfect solution.

This includes:

- Installation
- First 2 months rental then £50 per month thereafter payable by standing order

The Freecurve also has powered and automatic options to suit your exact needs. The almost limitless customisable options for the Freecurve make it the perfect stairlift for any home.



Handicare 2000

The Handicare 2000 uses a twin tube construction which delivers strength and stability whilst enabling tight bends, in fact this system offers the tightest bend that is available from any stairlift manufacturer making it an ideal choice for compact stairs and hallways.

The weight limit on the 2000 is 115 kg (18 st) and can be increased to 137 kg (21 $\frac{1}{2}$ st) with the heavy duty kit.





This double rail system, designed for a stable and smooth ride, is supplied in light grey, brown or gun metal as standard and is delivered in industry leading manufacturing times.

Handicare 4000

The Handicare 4000 uses a twin rail which delivers strength and stability whilst enabling tight bends, in fact this system offers the tightest bend that is available from any stairlift manufacturer making it an ideal choice for compact stairs and hallways.

The weight limit on the 4000 is 136 kg (21 st) and can be increased to 160 kg (25 st) with the heavy duty kit.



The Handicare 4000 is compatible with the Handicare Style, Smart, Simplicity and Perch seats.

Your questions answered

Hopefully by reading through our brochure we have answered any questions you may have, however we have answered some frequently asked questions below.

How long will I have to wait for my curved stairlift?

Once you have placed an order with Leodis Stairlifts your stairlift can often be installed within days, and in some cases, as quickly as the very NEXT day.

How long will it take to install my curved stairlift?

Our experienced, friendly engineer will fit your curved stairlift in approximately 3-4 hours, leaving your home as clean and tidy as it was found. He will demonstrate how to use your stairlift, answer any queries you may have and only when entirely satisfied do you pay.

Will my stairlift be attached to the wall?

Many people think that stairlifts are fixed to the wall however this is not the case. Your stairlift will be attached directly to the staircase itself. During your free home survey our Leodis engineer will advise you on the most convenient side of the stairs for your stairlift and if anything i.e. if a radiator may need to be moved.

What happens if there is a power cut?

Your stairlift will still work for a limited time if you have a power cut. The Bison 180 curved stairlift is battery operated and these re-charge when your stairlift is left on a charge point top or bottom of the track. Your curved stairlift will alert you by bleeping when it is not left on a charge point. If your stairlift batteries go flat they may need to be replaced.

Do you only sell new curved stairlifts?

We offer both new and reconditioned curved stairlifts, available for NEXT day delivery in most cases. We can also install our curved stairlifts on a rental basis.

What do I do when I need a new carpet?

The best time to replace your carpet is before installation however if this is not possible we can remove then reinstall your stairlift, a cost will be incurred for this service.

If you have any further questions or queries we will be happy to answer them in person.
